The format of the meeting includes; invited lecturers, panel discussions and poster presentations. A significant time of the 2 days meeting will be dedicated to open discussions.

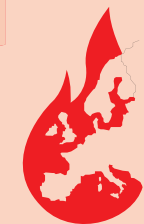
**TARGET GROUP**
